Sights have to be visited in Munich:

- *Frauenkirche*
The Frauenkirche is the landmark of Munich. The church was built in the 15th century. It has two towers with a height of 100m. One tower is opened for visitors, from there you can have a view over Munich.



- *Schloss Nymphenburg*
The castle Schloss Nymphenburg has a beautiful park with loads of flowers and fountains. You can go for a walk through the park and afterwards view the impressive building.



- *Marienplatz*
Marienplatz or you could also say the heart of Munich is one of the most famous places in Munich. It is in the middle of Munich's historic district where you can also find the town hall.



- *Hofbräuhaus*
After visiting all the sights your probably hungry. The Hofbräuhaus is the perfect place to get typical bavarian food and a typical bavarian beer. It was already built in 1608 and has place for 3400 guests.



- *Olympiapark*

The Olympiapark is a beautiful place that was grounded in 1972 for the Olympic Games in Germany. It is next to the Olympiastadion, the Olympiahalle and the Olympiaturm. In summer there are frequently festivals and concerts.



- *Deutsches Museum*

The Deutsches Museum is one of the largest scientific museums in the world. In 30 departments, originals and models illustrate how technology and the laws of nature work.
